

CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST TO SUPPORT STANDARDS CUP'S ORGANIZATION.

From 14th September to 14th October 2022, Rwanda Standards Board (RSB) organizes a standardization Month aiming at raising awareness on the contribution of standards to sustainable development initiatives undertaken by the Government of Rwanda.

The Standardization Month will be marked by various activities organized in a way that, awareness on contribution of standards to all concerned stakeholders and general public is provided, and these activities will be organized under the following three core components.

1. Hosting the international meeting for the newly established technical committee on circular economy **ISO/TC 323** from 25 to 30 September 2022.
2. Series of symposium to review the impact of standards on sustainable development initiatives undertaken by the Government of Rwanda for the previous 20 years from the establishment of the National Standards Body and draw new orientations.
3. Celebration of the World Standards Day 2022 under the theme “**Our shared vision for a better World**” as an effort to recognize standardization's integral role and immense contribution to the sustainable development agenda.

Additionally, given the size of the targeted audience, under the Standardization Month Framework, **Rwanda Standards Board (RSB)** jointly with **Fédération Rwandaise de Football Association** organizes the **Standards Cup** as an effective platform for awareness rising with a focus on achieving the following core objectives:

- Disseminating the contribution of standards and standardization services to the general public and other interested parties in promoting the safety of consumers and preservation of the environment;
- Providing a framework for promoting Made in Rwanda Manufacturers interested to brand their products during the tournament period;
- Raising awareness on standards applied in sports service management, sports infrastructures and tools;

The organization of this tournament has been designed to consider two categories of competitors; the **category one (professionals)** focusing on the Primus National League big four of the competition year 2021/2022 and the **category two (amateurs)** targeting the teams from the private sector and national quality infrastructure institutions applied to participate in the competition.

It is under this background that, RSB calls upon all stakeholders and other interested parties committed to continually support in awareness rising on the role of standards and standardization services to express their interest in the organization of this tournament.
